

Visitor Guidelines

A Notice to Our Visitors: All visitors are required to provide proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19, or a negative COVID-19 test* taken within the last 48 hours (PCR tests) or the last 24 hours (antigen tests), before visiting anyone in our care. *Home COVID-19 tests to not qualify.

Effective May 13, 2022 patients may have two visitors at a time. Exceptions are noted below.

Inpatient Departments: Medsurg/Telemetry/Perinatal/ICU

Visiting hours are from 8:00am- 8:00pm

- Patients in labor are allowed visitation at any time.

Two visitors are permitted with patient at a time

- Patients in labor may have up to 3 visitors at a time.

Visitation outside of approved hours may be considered individually to meet specific patient needs. Such requests must be directed to the house supervisor.

Outpatient Departments: Emergency/ OP Surgery/Special Procedures/Radiology

One support person is permitted with the patient.

Visitor Screening

- Proof of Vaccine or negative COVID test and mask must be worn over nose and mouth.

Unvaccinated:

- Negative antigen test within one day, or negative PCR within two days. Home COVID-19 tests to not qualify.

Unvaccinated Exceptions:

- Patients at end of life
- Labor support person, department will test the primary support person
- Support person for cognitive, developmental, intellectual, or physical impairment
