Visitor Guidance Update October 11, 2022

- Visitors are no longer required to show proof of vaccination or a negative test to have indoor visitation.
- Covid positive patients:
 - No visitors during the isolation and infectious time period unless near end
 of life or parent(s) of a pediatric patient or L&D support person(s)
- Visitor Masking:
 - Appropriate masks worn over nose and mouth, staff should reinforce and model appropriate behavior

Inpatient Departments

Visiting hours are from 8:00am- 8:00pm. Only 2 visitors are permitted with each patient at the same time. Children under 12; at the discretion of the primary nurse.

- a. <u>Maternity</u> Significant other/Newborn's parent may visit at any time. Siblings, grandparents arrange visitation with primary nurse. Patients in labor may have up to three visitors at a time
- b. <u>IICN(NICU)</u> Parent or guardian will determine who may visit and must be present and to accompany the visitor, no more than 2 visitors at a time
- c. Patients may have a support person with them after visiting hours if requested and it supports a healing environment
- d. Patients at end of life or near death may have additional visitors at anytime at the discretion of nursing leadership
- e. Any visitation restrictions must be approved by administrative team.
